The Charleston Area Justice Ministry (CAJM) has been selected to receive the 2018 Harvey Gantt Triumph Award. This award was named for the "noted Architect, Academician and Civic leader who became the first black student at Clemson Agricultural College of South Carolina, later named Clemson University."

The Gantt Triumph Award will be presented to CAJM's 2017 co-presidents, Rev. Dr. Jeremy Rutledge and Rev. Charles Heyward, during the powerful [MLK ecumenical service](#) at Charleston's Morris Street Baptist Church at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 14.


Join us! The service is free and open to the public; a crowd of more than 1,000 is expected. Michael B. Moore, president and CEO of the International African American Museum will be the Keynote speaker.

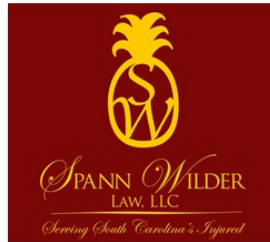
