In 2013, CAJM's members voiced concerns about the number of children who were suspended or expelled from CCSD schools. A close look at the suspension data indicated *Black and Brown students were almost 10x more likely to be suspended or expelled than white students.* Research indicated successful implementation of <u>Restorative Practices</u> to foster relationships between teachers and students and among students was successful in reducing suspensions and expulsions in schools across the country. CAJM began to advocate for implementation of Restorative Practices in CCSD schools.

The 2022 election brings a change in the CCSD school board elections. One candidate will be elected from each of 9 districts. CAJM sent a survey to each of the candidates with questions about their expectations for school climate, discipline and suspensions, their ideas on improving school climate, and their support for implementation of Restorative Practices in the schools.
