Did you know?

- Black, Latinx and Indigenous People are more likely to be displaced from their homes during hurricane-related floods and face more obstacles rebuilding afterward.
- Predominantly white neighborhoods have 11 times more green space than those where 40% or more of residents are Black or of a different ethnicity.
