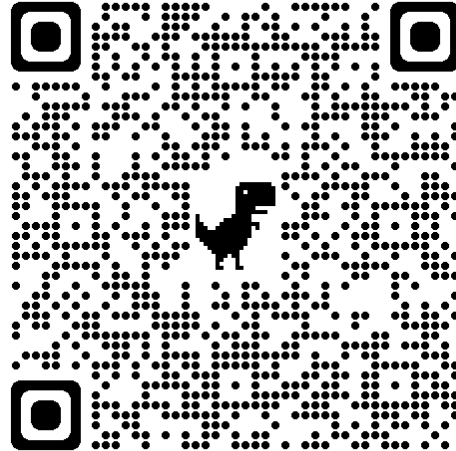

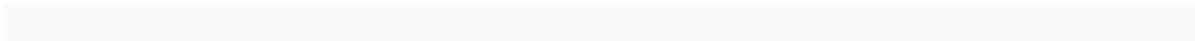
Have you made your 2022 investment in CAJM?
