And we've been pushing Charleston County for YEARS to establish and fund an Affordable Housing Trust Fund, but they continue to refuse. Even now, as they are poised to receive \$80 MILLION in federal Covid-relief funding, they will not agree to dedicate ANY of those funds to affordable housing. **This December, the Charleston County Council has an incredible opportunity** to be generous, and to live into the true values of what the holiday season is all about. Instead, their behavior is more Grinch-like than anything else. It's time for us to come together to STOP THE GRINCH. And we won't be able to do this without all of you. It's time for us to use our people power and show up in mass to encourage the Charleston County Council to use the Covidrelief money they are receiving to give the gift of affordable housing to so many in our community who are struggling to make ends meet! So please join our Housing Committee on Tuesday, December 7 (that's tomorrow!) at the Lonnie Hamilton Building (4045 Bridge View Drive) to show your support for allocating some of the Covid-relief money to an Affordable Housing Trust Fund!
