Nearly 50 CAJM members gathered last week outside of County Council to call on Charleston County to release the Housing our Future plan which is intended to lay out how the County will attack the worsening affordable housing crisis. The County was set to release the plan in mid-November but is now holding off until the new year.



The Post & Courier covered the rally, stating:

"'The Charleston region's affordable housing problem is no secret,' according to the county's Housing Our Future website.

Rents jumped by 30 percent or more during the past two years in three cities — Charleston, North Charleston and Mount Pleasant, according to Apartment List's database. As of October, a home in the county fetched a median price of \$520,000, according to Redfin.

Some people, as a result, are relocating toward the rural edges of the suburbs. Others resort to shared living."
