- 1. Reinstate Dr Eric Gallien to his position as Superintendent of CCSD schools
- 2. Hire Michelle Simmons as Chief Academic Officer
- 3. Reinstate the 6 members of the Health Advisory Council who were replaced before their terms were up
- 4. Reinstate public comments to the Committee of the Whole Meeting

You may also email your state legislators and ask them to allow runoff voting (currently two of our Board members were elected with less a dozen votes)
