



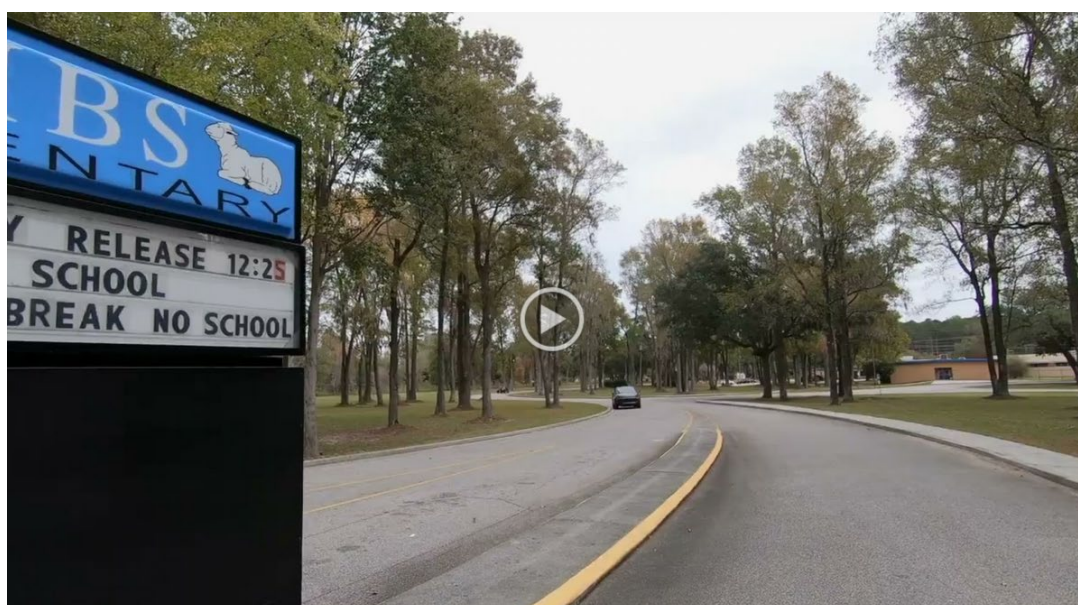

## Last call to join the CAJM choir and sing at the Nehemiah Action!

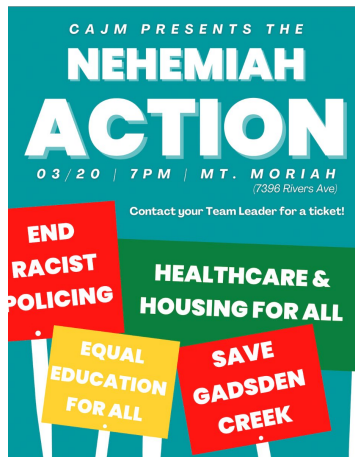

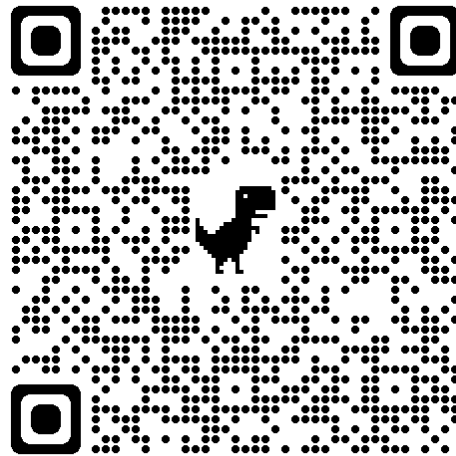
