## Charleston County School Board Re-cap

CAJM Team Leaders and Network Members attended the June 24 Charleston County School Board meeting to raise concern about district leadership not consistently following policy. More specifically, the board has not placed its current superintendent on leave following a recent workplace complaint by a staff member. This is a startling contradiction of how the board handled a workplace complaint last fall against a Black superintendent, Eric Gallien.

CAJM reiterated CAJM's call for a comprehensive audit of practice and an evaluation of the superintendent's role.

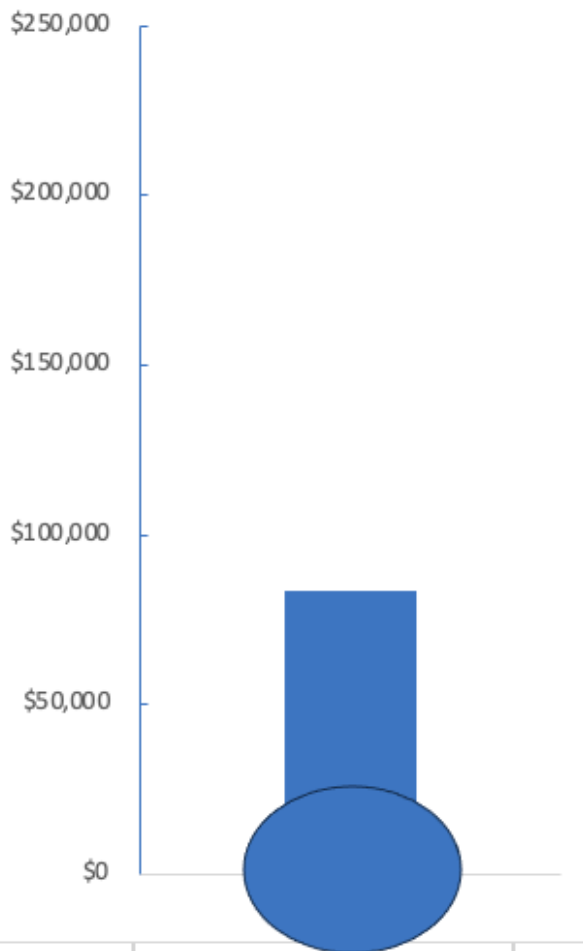

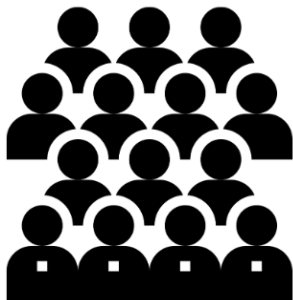

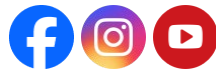
