We are in the season of Advent, a time of hope and this week we celebrate with our Jewish community members as Hanukkah began this past Sunday, December 14th.

Our hearts are heavy as we hold in prayer the victims and families affected by the Bondi Beach shooting and victims of gun violence everywhere. We grieve with those who grieve. We stand with those who are afraid. And we pray for comfort, healing, and peace for all those whose lives have been shattered by these acts of violence.

In moments like these, our interfaith bonds mean everything. Across our traditions, we share a commitment to human dignity and the sacredness of life. We mourn together. We hold each other up. And we refuse to let hate divide us or fear paralyze us.

Hanukkah celebrates light overcoming darkness and the courage to stand up for what's right. Each night, families light one more candle on the menorah, refusing to let darkness have the final word. At the heart of this season is **tikkun olam** "repairing the world" the sacred practice of working for justice and healing in our communities.

This is our work too. Right here in Charleston, across our 40 congregations and partner organizations, we are lighting candles together. When we fight for affordable housing, protect our environment, and demand police accountability, we're doing our part to repair our corner of the world. We're building a community where everyone, regardless of their faith, race, or background, can live safely, with dignity, and without fear.

We pray that our work here will ripple outward. That others will see what's possible when people of different faiths and backgrounds come together in love and justice. That our acts of repair will inspire others to join us in creating communities where violence has no home and every person is valued.

Please join us in wishing our Jewish members "Happy Hanukkah" and letting them know they are held in our prayers and hearts during this holy season.

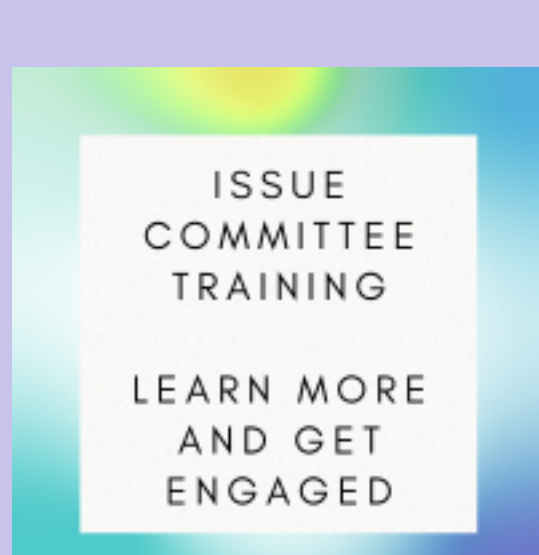

Clergy: Join Us in Orlando, FL

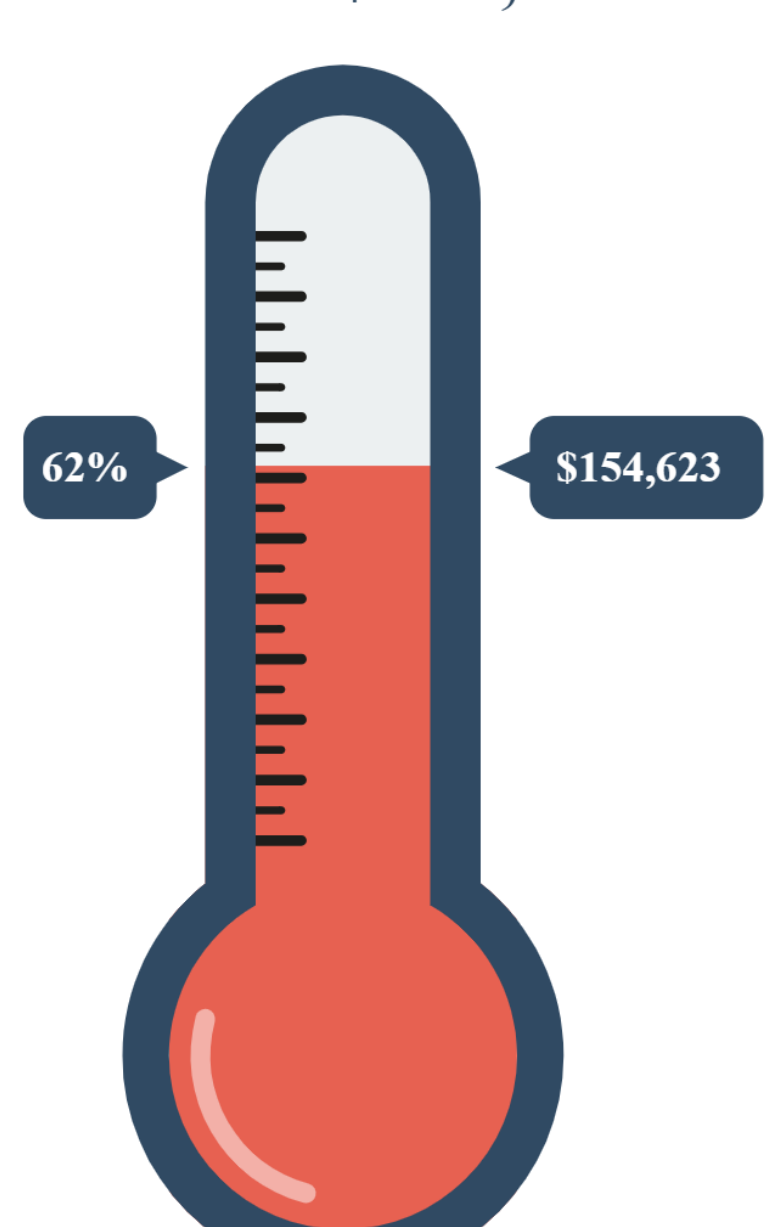

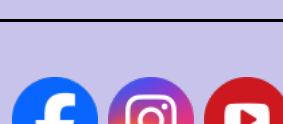
