After persistent advocacy by our CAJM community, the North Charleston Police Department is honoring their commitment to meet with us about the Racial Bias Audit implementation. This forum is our opportunity to exercise the power we built together to hold NCPD accountable to the changes our community demands.

What's at Stake: The Racial Bias Audit revealed troubling patterns in traffic stops and police interactions. NCPD committed to changes. Now we need to see the data, hear about progress, **AND** ask the hard questions about whether officers are truly changing how they engage with our community.

Your Role and Your Power: NCPD didn't call this meeting. **WE** did. Our network organized, our leaders pushed, and now they're here to respond. That means **we set the tone.** We ask the questions. We decide if the answers are good enough.

- Come Prepared To:**
- Ask specific questions about the data being presented
 - Demand clarity on how changes are improving traffic stops and daily police interactions
 - Challenge vague promises with requests for measurable outcomes
 - Share your own experiences and what real accountability looks like

This forum is the **beginning of ongoing dialogue**, not the end. The quality of this conversation and whether it leads to real change depends on how we show up. Informed. United. Unafraid to use our collective voice

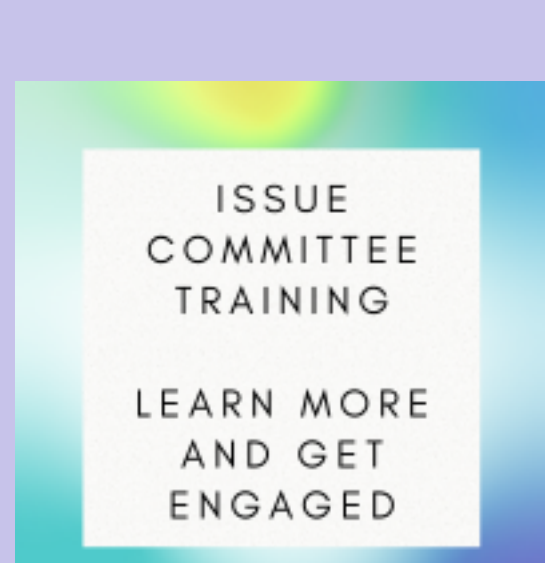

Connect with faith leaders, share strategies, and build the partnerships that fuel our movement for change.

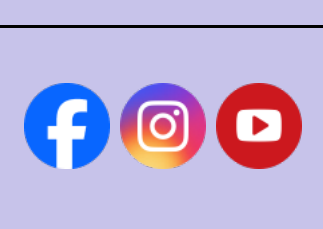
