Here are some tips for inviting people to the Action:

- Start early! Giving people the date in advance allows them to block it off on their calendar.
- Think about why that person might want to come. What do you know about them and their values? Which of our issues might they be interested in? Make the invitation around their interests, not your.
- Remind often! Set up a time to follow up with your invitees. An easy way to do this is by checking in with them about transportation or seeing if they have questions.
- Be yourself. People respond best to genuine connection and conversation, not to a script.
- Remember, you don't need to know every detail about our issues to invite someone. If they have questions you can't answer, ask a Team Leader or Organizer!

Our Network Meetings helped us to plan our invitation lists. **Next up, the Rally is going to help us stay inspired. At the Rally on March 23**, we'll come together to lift one another up, and we will learn what to expect at the Nehemiah Action. We'll also work together to make sure we're on track to reach our goal of 1,200 people in the room on April 27th!

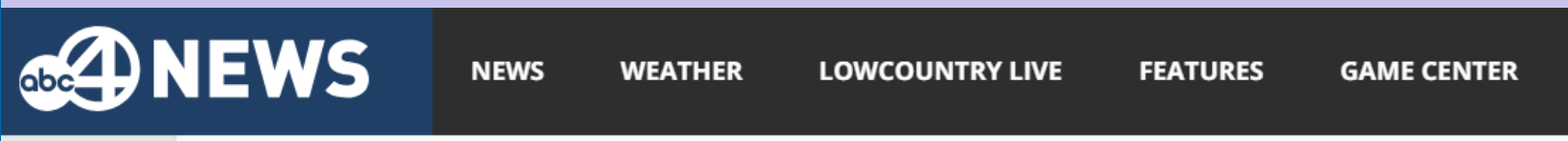
Help Us Tell the Story of Food Insecurity in Charleston

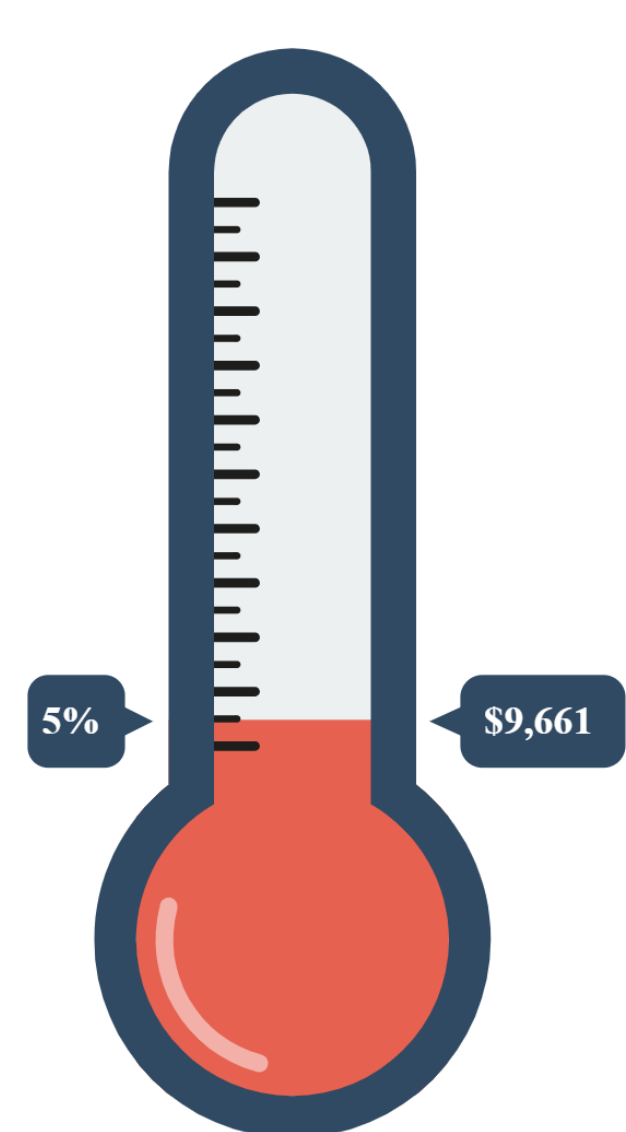
