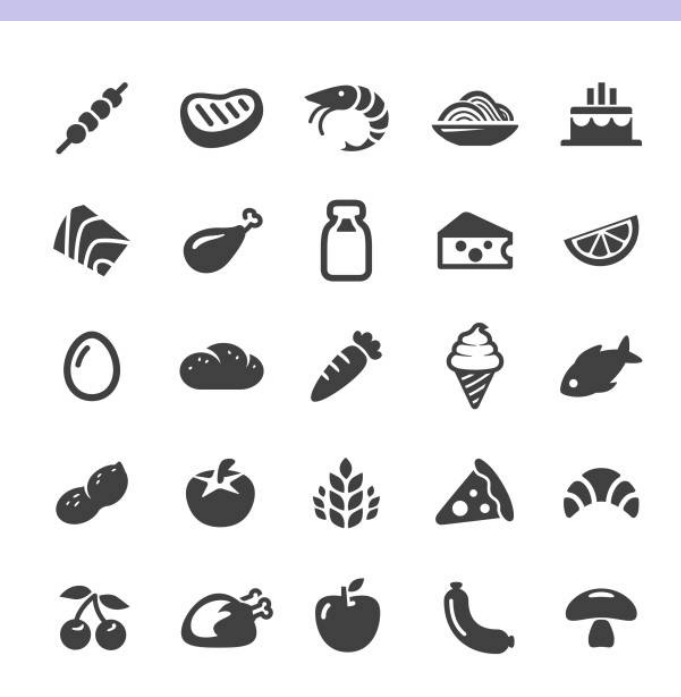
What: CAJM Board of Directors Meeting

Who: CAJM Members interested in being part of our Food Insecurity research process! We will meet with representatives of LCFB to continue deepening our understanding of the problem and what we can do.

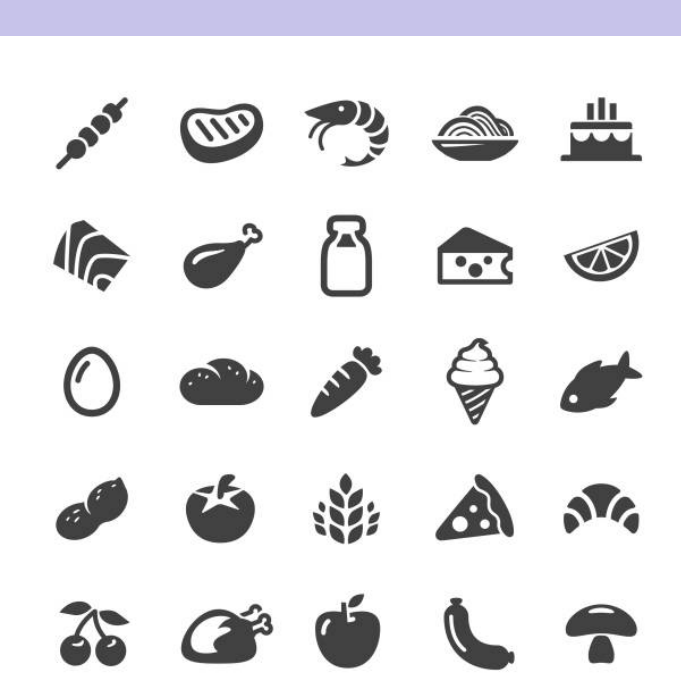
