**Three things to do right now — all three, today:**

2. Call your list and confirm every person you invited
3. Get them [registered](#) or make sure they have a [ticket](#)

You have been doing the work. Now we finish strong. A yes without a completed registration is a seat we cannot count on. Go down your list and make sure every person is confirmed and fully registered before the Action.

**When you arrive**

Doors open at 6:00 PM -arrive on time. Program begins at 6:30 PM - be seated and ready. Parking directors will be on site to guide you when you arrive.

**This night belongs to the whole community.**

The Nehemiah Action is not just for people living with these issues; it is for every person who believes that when we stand together, we are powerful enough to create change. This is about wielding our collective power, holding elected officials accountable, and building a community where there is enough for all of us. Bring your people. There is room for everyone.

**What we are pressing for:**

**FOOD ACCESS** — A widespread crisis with a local solution

Across our region, too many families cannot reliably access fresh, affordable food. When people go without, the harm reaches into every part of life — higher rates of chronic illness, children who cannot focus in school, families stretched beyond what any individual should have to carry alone. 1 in 5 children in South Carolina faces food insecurity with lasting consequences for health, learning, and opportunity. This is a structural failure, and our region has both the resources and the responsibility to fix it. We are demanding real, government-supported investment in food access, because every family deserves a table with enough on it.

**GADSDEN CREEK** — A living resource worth protecting

We continue to press elected officials toward the creation of the Just Ecological Corridor, and we stand with the residents who live near Gadsden Creek, people who know the creek. It mitigates flooding and connects this community to land and water that have sustained it for generations. That access must be protected.

**SCHOOL GOVERNANCE** — Our children cannot wait

The decisions made in CCSD boardrooms shape the future of every child in this county. For too long, families have been left out watching accountability deferred and trust broken. With school board elections on the horizon, the people who fill those seats will determine what our schools look like for years to come. Monday night, we make clear that those leaders answer to the families they serve.

This is not about any one issue. This is about what happens when a community refuses to be ignored and shows up together to demand change.

**Confirm. Register. Bring your 3.**

Go down your list. Call everyone who said yes, confirm they are still coming, and make sure their ticket is completely filled out. Then ask who they are bringing. **Everyone brings 3.** There is enough power, enough room, and enough at stake for all of us.

**CALL SCRIPT** — Confirmation and registration

Open: "Hey [name], it's [your name]. I'm following up — the Nehemiah Action is Monday, April 27th at Mount Moriah. Doors open at 6, program starts at 6:30. Are you still coming?"

Confirm: "Have you finished registering? We need to count you in our 1,200."

Register: "I'm texting you the link right now — it only takes a minute. Can you fill it out while I have you?"

Their 3: "And who are you bringing? We need everyone to bring 3. Is there one more person you can call today?"

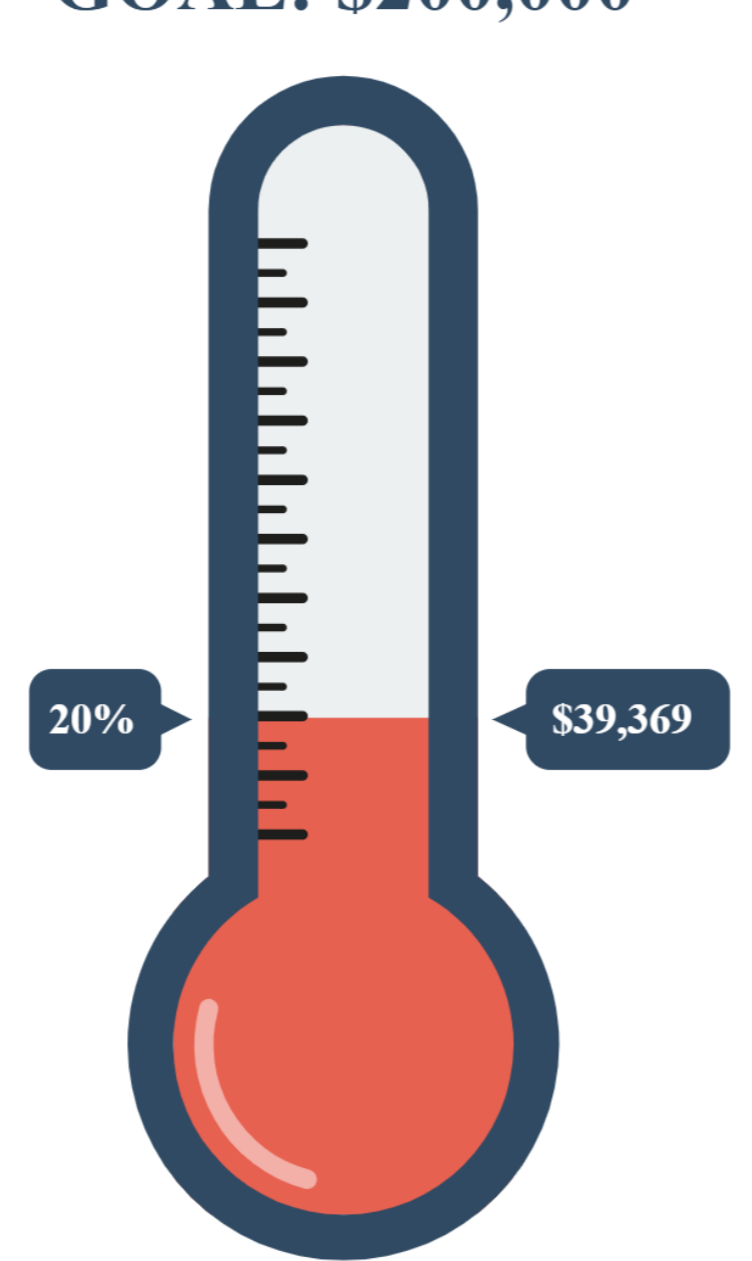

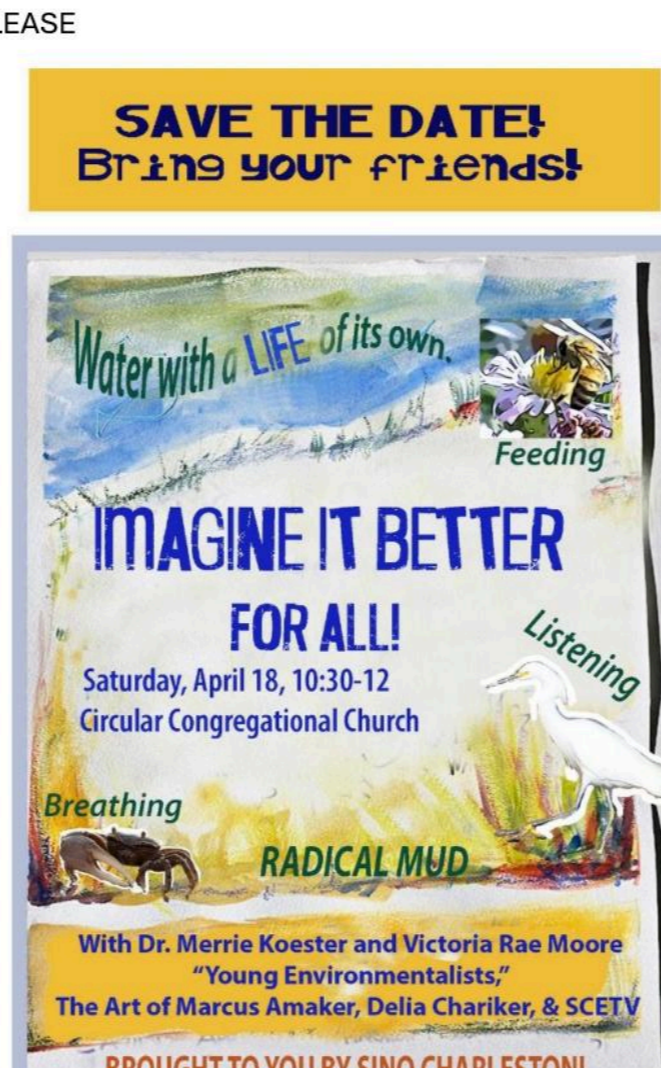

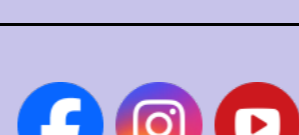
