Somewhere in Charleston County right now, someone is choosing between groceries and rent. A grandparent is skipping meals so a grandchild can eat. A family doesn't even have a ride to full shelves at a grocery store they can't even afford.

This is happening in one of the most abundant regions in the country. And many of us are working, helping, and supporting in every way we can. And still, people are going hungry. That is not acceptable. It was never acceptable. And it doesn't have to be this way.

Since November, CAJM has been having real and tough conversations about hunger and access to food. What it looks like, who it affects, how it's funded, where it comes from. What we learned is that hunger is more than a few humble beautiful souls on a street corner asking for change. It's more than growling bellies in the classroom. It's much more than beans and rice for dinner three times a week. We learned, hunger in Charleston is not a scarcity problem. It is a justice problem. The food exists. The resources exist. *The Will Exists!*

Food is a right and not a privilege. All deserve access to healthy food that nourishes.

From that listening came a clear call: ***we need a coordinated, collaborative approach to food access*** — one that connects the resources we already have and puts them to work for everyone. The will exists. The system just needs to be built. And CAJM has always been in the business of building. Affordable Housing. Unbiased Policing. Equitable Schools. And now, Accessible Food.

On Monday night we need you to show up. To do your part in beginning to shape a new model for the Charleston area around food access. We need you to come out and support our request for more coordination and support for those on the ground who are working tirelessly to make sure that all of us have access to healthy food.

Whether hunger has touched your household directly or not, you are connected to someone it has. A member of your congregation. A neighbor down the street. A child in your community's school. As Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. reminded us from a Birmingham jail, "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere. We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality, tied in a single garment of destiny. Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly."

Every person — regardless of income, zip code, or circumstance — has the right to eat. Not just to survive, but to eat well. Fresh food. Healthy food. Food that nourishes.

That right is under threat right now. Across the country, federal cuts are slashing the programs millions of families depend on — SNAP, WIC, school meal programs, and food bank support. What was already hard is becoming harder. What was already a gap is becoming a crisis. Our local leaders have the power and the funding to act, and we have the will to make sure it gets done.

This is the beginning — not the end. Monday night opens a conversation our whole region needs to have. Come be part of what comes next.

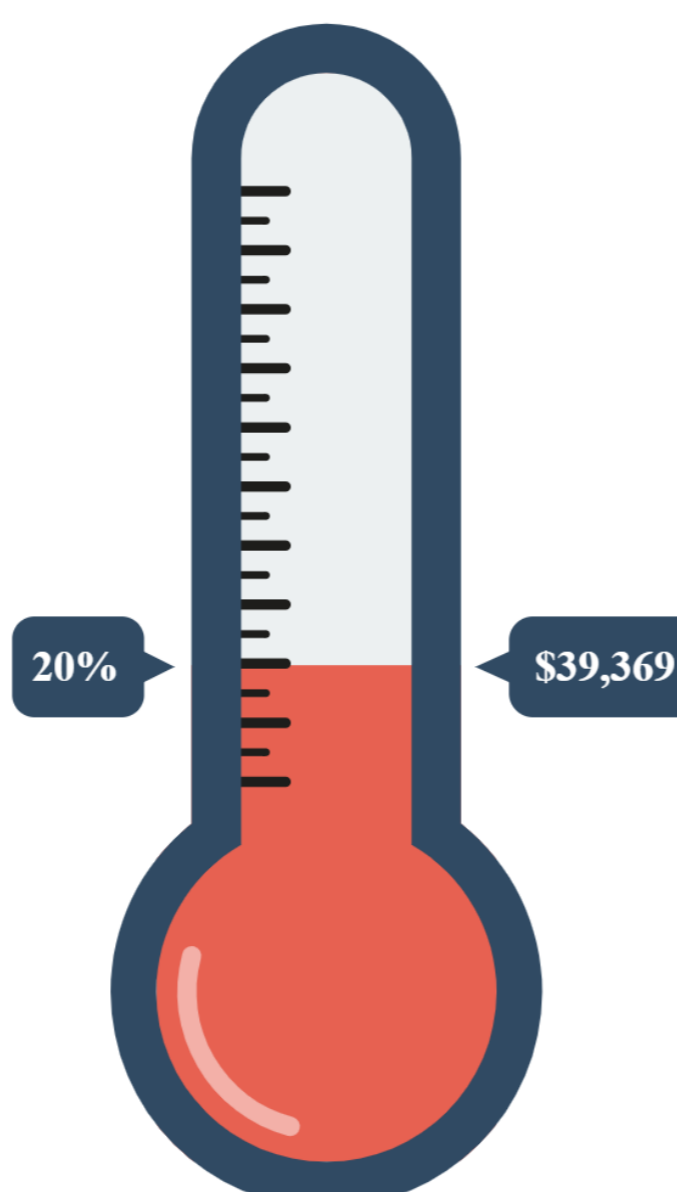
CAJM's Annual Celebration!!
