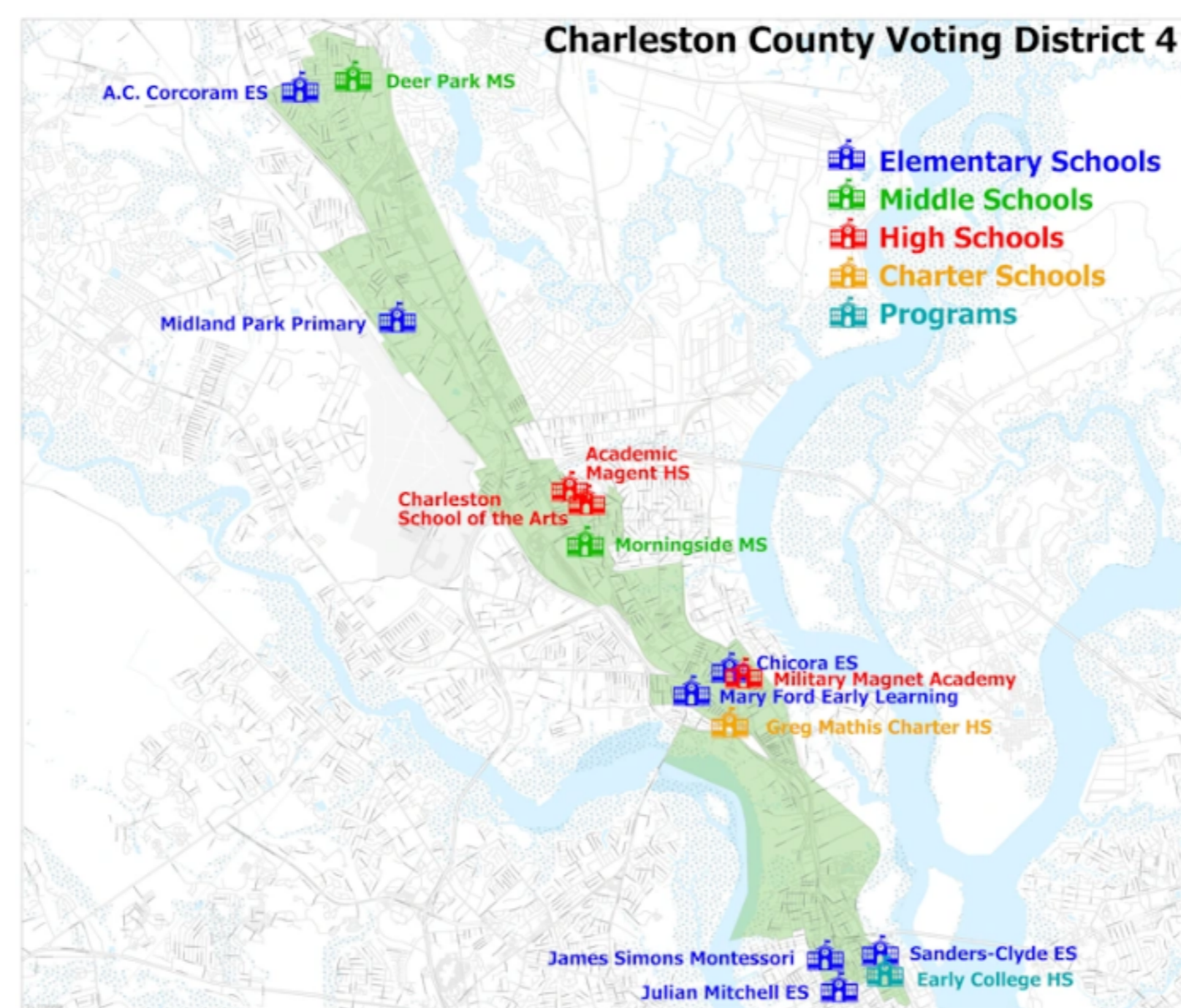

### Charleston School Board District 4 Special Election!



**If you are in CCSD District #4 and plan on voting early:**

**Vote at this location: County Voter Registration Office: 4340 Corporate Road, North Charleston, SC 29405**

Voters MUST check in for BOTH elections primary and school board special election. Be sure to let poll workers know you want to vote in both the Charleston County School Board Special Election and the Statewide Primary. These are separate ballots, so you must request each one.

If you live in District 4 and already voted in the statewide primary but not the CCSD special election, go back and request the special election ballot!

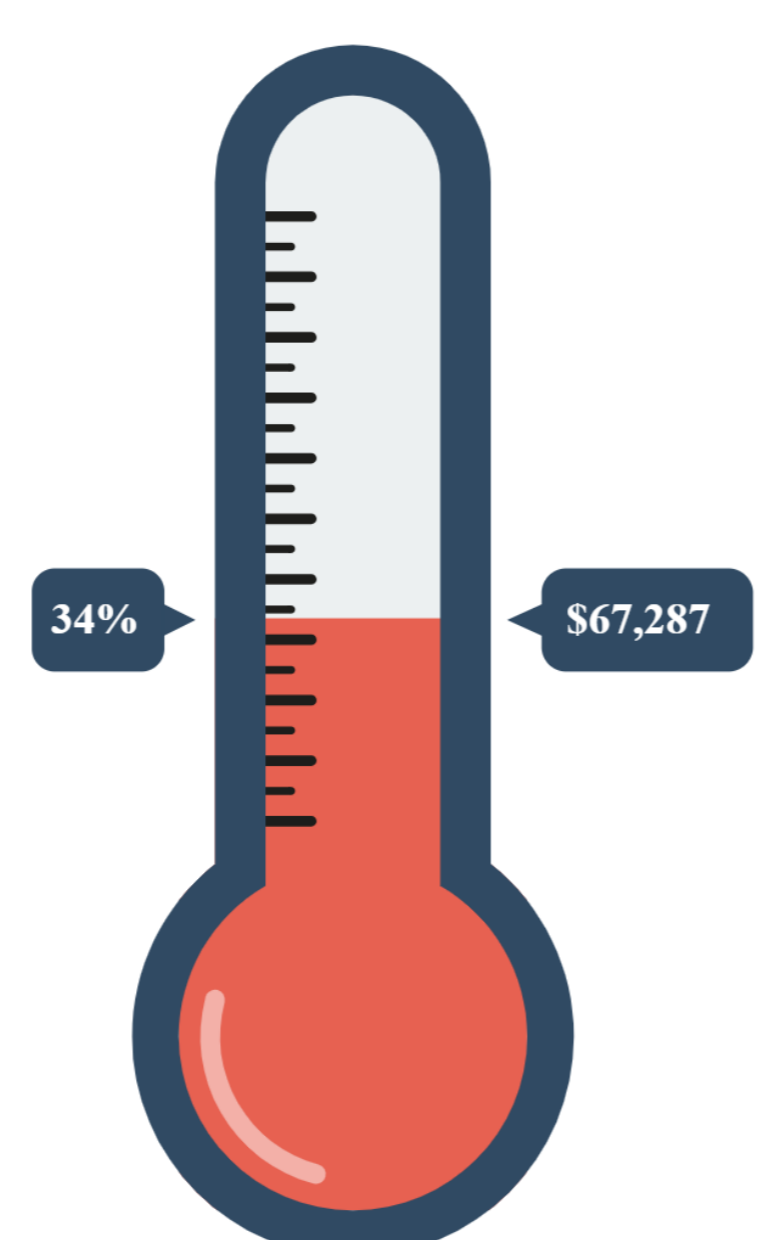
